Become an EXCEL Center Tutor

The EXCEL undergraduate tutor will be responsible for providing academic assistance to the EXCEL/COMPASS program students. Typically, that entails:

- Strong understanding of the subject matter they are tutoring.
- Staffing the EXCEL Center (5~10 hours/week):
 - Able to explain concepts clearly and effectively.
 - Provide individual or group tutoring sessions to help students with key concepts, definitions, and principles.
 - Provide student guidance and support with homework assignments, test prep, study habits. Be able to connect students to resources when necessary.
- \$14 per hour

Required Credentials, Skills and Expectations:

- Good academic standing as an undergraduate student (preferred 3.0 GPA or higher).
- Successful experience the course(s) in which they wish to tutor (Grade of A/B).
- Experience teaching either in an official role at UCF or at another institution will also be helpful.
- Applicants must be in good standing at the University of Central Florida.
- Must provide a faculty member name as a reference.
