Become an EXCEL Math Learning Assistant

Learning Assistants are undergraduates we hire to improve how students learn calculus. Typically, that entails:

- acting as a resource for students during a Calculus 1 class in which the LA earned an A (6 hours/week)
- planning with the instructor for the class the LA works with (1-2 hours /week)
- staffing the EXCEL Center (2-3 hours/week)
- \$15 per hour for 10 hours employment per week for fall semester (could go up to 15 hours)

Required Credentials, Skills and Expectations:

- Good academic standing as an undergraduate student (preferred 3.0 GPA or higher)
- Successful experience in math courses required (Grade of A in MAC 2311 minimal)
- **Must take Learning Assistant training course in Fall 2026.** This is an asynchronous webcourse with 4-5 synchronous virtual meetings throughout the term.
- **Must attend MAC 2311 lecture on T/Th 10:30 am-12:20 pm**
- Must attend weekly meetings with math faculty member and graduate teaching assistants (included in your 10 hours of employment).
- Must provide a faculty member name as a reference.
